HISTORY

The first Central Coast rally was held at the Terrigal High Auditorium in March 1990. It was the brainchild of Elaine and John S. A large number of local members provided enthusiastic support. AA members came to the first rally from all over NSW. The novelty of it provided considerable momentum in the beginning.

From 1999 onwards the annual rallies were held variously at La Salle Kincumber, Gosford Public School, San Remo Community Centre, Bateau Bay Public School and finally for four years at The Entrance Community Centre, where the last to date before the pandemic, was held in 2019. Each of the 30 rallies so far, have been an unqualified success.
