An Open Letter to Health Professionals

Dear Colleagues,

Alcohol use disorder and issues associated with heavy drinking are routinely identified across many disciplines and continue to pose a hazard to many patients and their families. Please keep in mind that a referral to Alcoholics Anonymous can be a life-saving event.

In March 2020, The Cochrane Review was able to document, from 21 randomised controlled trials, that the clinical process of Twelve Step Facilitation increases engagement in Alcoholics Anonymous. It also showed that engagement with AA was more often enduringly effective than comparable interventions, resulting in substantial health economic dividends.

Simple referral to Alcoholics Anonymous will produce results. Developing a clinical system which educates patients about AA and encourages them to engage with AA has been demonstrated to be as or more effective than other systems and to produce measurably cheaper outcomes.

A link to the Cochrane Review is below. Sober members of AA are willing and eager to provide further information and literature. Just contact your local AA office.
